92Y After School Programming (K-12)

After-school enrichment and remote learning support programs, including gymnastics, games, and arts & crafts.

Atlantic Acting School (K-12)

The Atlantic Acting School trains and mentors artists of various ages and backgrounds. Students will learn to break through their creative comfort zones to bring essential human stories to life.

Bread and Yoga (K-5) Outdoor and online yoga after-school.

Brooklyn Game Lab (K-12)

Provides indoor tutoring and outdoor and online breaks during the school day as well as indoor, outdoor, and online after-school programs.

Counselors come equipped with supplies and ready to play, but ultimately the kids control the agenda. Offers options to pair up with other families in the area to create "pods".

Steve and Kate's Online (K-8)

Kids log on and have options to participate in crafts, creative activities, physical activities, games, and dance.

Tip Top Brain Live Online Tutoring (K-12)

Offers live, weekly, grade-level instruction in all subjects, including assistance with homework or subject-specific trouble-shooting in a small-group or private setting.

TADA! Online Winter Semester Classes (K-12)

Offers a variety of interactive, fun online musical theater classes for all ages and abilities. These online classes offer musical theater training and opportunities to stay active and make connections with new friends from all over the world.

Tech Camp 1-on-1 Private Lessons (K-12)

The Coding Space (3-12)

Students will work one-on-one or in small groups to learn coding. The program balances screen time with hands-on activities fostering creativity and exploration.

Amas Musical Theatre's award-winning after-school program offers classes in singing, acting, dance, and related performance skills, with special Guest Artist Workshops.

The Tiny Scientist Monthly Pod Science Program (K-5)

The Tiny Scientist has multiple sessions per day to help families with unpredictable schedules. They feature outdoor, state-standard aligned hands-on Science, STEM toys free-play and a non-fiction read aloud that supports the science of the day.

Upper Manhattan Forest Kids (Up to age 6)

Outdoor classes held in Central Park; modeled on nature kindergarten.

Writopia Lab (K-12)

In both multi-genre and themed workshops, writers in age-based groups work with a published author or produced playwright (highly trained in teaching the form, genre, or topic). Participants discuss, share, develop, and complete their own original works.
